- January 18, 2001
- TDD Training is supplied by the state twice a year through the Council of Government in each area.
 - 9-1-1 Public Educators of Texas logo committee formed.
- April 11, 2001
- 9-1-1 Wireless Campaigns begin.
 - Responsibilities set for hosting a 9-1-1 PET Workshop.
- July 26, 2001
- The National Emergency Number Association (NENA) contacted six state chapters including Texas Emergency Number Association (TENA) to find out if state chapters would be interested in participating in a National Kid Hero Program.
 - Telecommunicator Awards Presentation questions answered
 - Awards organized through CSEC
 - Nominations sent to PSAPS, districts, COGs and HRC
 - Heroes are selected by people from metro, rural areas, dispatchers and TENA
 - Copies for nominations for Telecommunicator of the Year (TC), Silent Hero (SH) and Team Merit Award (TM) are made and given to judges for them to decide on winners. At the end of three days, CSEC calls judges for their votes.
 - Funding for TC, SH and TM were discussed
