- January 25, 2005

 - Voted that in the Resource Manual CD a vendor list in Excel format will be added. No ratings will be given.
 - CSEC reported that Cell Phone Sally will be copyrighted soon
 - It was reported that the phrase, “When Seconds Count” had been copyrighted by the Public Safety Group in Oklahoma
 - The Texas Trainer Forum, (a group of 9-1-1 trainers from the PETs) is now meeting
 - Hosting a 9-1-1 Public Educator’s Workshop responsibilities were handed out
- May 24, 2005

 - Cell Phone Sally is copyrighted by CSEC
 - CSEC gave information on 9-1-1 Telecommunicator award nominations: one Silent Hero per PSAP, one Team award and 10 Telecommunicators of the year would be honored at the TENA conference
